



LOCAL RULES

- 1. Out Of Bounds (Rule 27-1).** (a) Beyond all fences or hedges marking the perimeter of the golf course, (b) Beyond all white posts, (c) Out of bounds posts to the right of hole 11 do not apply whilst playing hole 12.
- 2. Water Hazards (Rule 26).** Lateral Hazards – Defined by Red Stakes.
Water Hazards – Defined by Yellow Stakes.
- 3. Staked Trees.** If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or arc of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped within one club length from the nearest point of relief not nearer the hole.
- 4. Immoveable Obstructions (Rule 24-2).** (a) Estate entry roads and buggy pathways, (b) Any footpath signs, stiles or bridges, (c) Distance markers.
- 5. Any Drainage.** On 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 6th, 7th, 8th, 11th, 12th & 18th, without penalty, dropped within one club length from the nearest point of relief not nearer the hole.
- 6. Ground Under Repair (Rule 25-1).** (a) If a ball lies within marked GUR or if the area interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the player **must** take relief. The ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped within one club length from the nearest point of relief not nearer the hole.
- 7. Stones In Bunkers.** May be removed without penalty.
- 8. Overhead Wires.** A ball striking an overhead wire must be replayed without penalty.
- 9. Distance-Measuring Devices (Rule 14-3).** For all play at Donnington Grove Country Club, a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of rule 14-3.
